The Chair laid HB 4710 before the committee:

HB 4710

(Rep. Kahle) A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code, "by amending sections 16215, 16322, 16501, 16511, 16521, 16525, and 16529 (MCL 333.16215, 333.16322, 333.16501, 333.16511, 333.16521, 333.16525, and 333.16529), section 16215 as amended by 2005 PA 211, sections 16322, 16501, 16525, and 16529 as added by 2006 PA 30, section 16511 as amended by 2006 PA 397, and section 16521 as amended by 2010 PA 79, and by adding sections 16513, 16515, and 16517.

HB 4052

(Rep. Whiteford) A bill to provide for licensing of adult residential psychiatric programs; to allow for psychiatric services to be provided in residential facilities; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state

departments and agencies; to prescribe certain fees; and to provide for penalties and remedies.
