## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by Chair Tyrone Carter.

The Chair laid HB 4322 before the committee:

HB 4322 (Rep. Coleman)

A bill to amend 2018 IL 1, entitled "Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act," by amending the title and sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 10, and 11 (MCL 333.27953, 333.27954, 333.27955, 333.27958, 333.27960, and 333.27961), sections 3 and 8 as amended by 2021 PA 56.

Representative Mueller moved to report out HB 4322 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 15-0-0:
