Governor Brucker, Born 1894

Wilber Brucker was born in Saginaw on June 23, 1894. Brucker graduated from the University of Michigan Law School in 1916, and joined the Michigan National Guard. He served at the Mexican border on the Pancho Villa Expedition, and then in France during World War I.

After the war, Brucker became the prosecuting attorney of Saginaw County and then, the Michigan Attorney General. Brucker was elected governor in 1930 while Michigan residents were suffering from the Great Depression.

Although Brucker did create a depression-relief plan, he considered direct welfare assistance to be a local issue, and not the responsibility of the state.

Although Brucker was not elected to a second term, he went on to serve as Secretary of the Army from 1955 to 1961. His portrait hangs at the third floor rotunda railing.
