HB 4287 Haveman Labor; fair employment practices; fair and open competition in governmental construction act; create.

Representative Brown moved to report HB 4287 with recommendation the bill be referred to the House Standing Committee on Commerce.

HB 4159 Lund Retirement; state employees; sunset on 3% employee retirement; repeal.
