The House Committee on Families, Children, and Seniors was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair laid HB 5611 and HB 5612 before the committee:

HB 5611 (Rep. Alexander)

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act," by amending sections 4 and 21 (MCL 205.94 and 205.111), as amended by 2021 PA 109.

HB 5612 (Rep. Alexander)

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," by amending sections 4a and 25 (MCL 205.54a and 205.75), as amended by 2021 PA 108.

Representative Julie Alexander, the bill sponsor for HB 5611 and HB 5612, explained the (H-1) substitutes to the bills. Questions and comments followed.
