## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Tuesday, May 16, 2023

10:30 AM

Room 327, House Office Building

The House Committee on Elections was called to order by Chair Tsernoglou.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Byrnes moved to adopt the meeting minutes from May 9, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4076 before the committee:

HB 4076 (Rep. Fink)

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending section 558 (MCL 168.558), as amended by 2021 PA 158.

Representative Fink testified in support of HB 4076. Questions and discussion followed.

Majority Vice Chair Wegela laid HB 4230 and HB 4234 before the committee:

HB 4230 (Rep. Wilson)

A bill to amend 1978 PA 390, entitled "An act to regulate the time and manner of payment of wages and fringe benefits to employees; to prescribe rights and responsibilities of employers and employees, and the powers and duties of the department of labor; to require keeping of records; to provide for settlement of disputes regarding wages and fringe benefits; to prohibit certain practices by employers; to prescribe penalties and remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," by amending section 7 (MCL 408.477), as amended by 2015 PA 15.

HB 4234 (Rep. Tsernoglou)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act," by amending sections 52, 54, 55, and 57 (MCL 169.252, 169.254, 169.255, and 169.257), sections 52 and 57 as amended by 2015 PA 269 and sections 54 and 55 as amended by 2019 PA 93.

Representative Wilson and Representative Tsernoglou testified in support of HB 4230 and HB 4234. Questions and discussion followed.

At 10:51 AM, Majority Vice Chair Wegela laid the committee at ease.

At 10:52 AM, the Chair called the committee back to order.

Mike Huerta, representing the United Auto Workers, testified in support of HB 4230 and HB 4234.
