### COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, June 8, 2023

The House Committee on Labor was called to order by Chair Haadsma.

The Chair laid HB 4034 before the committee:

HB 4034 (Rep. Hope)

A bill to regulate temporary labor service agencies, their clients, and temporary laborers; to prohibit retaliation for exercising rights granted under this act; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state officers and entities; to provide for the promulgation of rules; and to provide remedies and sanctions.

Representative Hope, and Chris White, representing the Restaurant Opportunity Centers of Michigan, testified in support of HB 4034. Questions and discussion followed.
