- Since 1996, MBHA has donated over \$400,000 to defend hunting rights in AK, CA, FL, NJ, MI, MD, ME, OH.
- Since 2002, our scholarship program has awarded over \$100,000 to over 80 students pursuing higher education.
- Have successfully worked closely with and promote Michigan's natural resources and outdoor heritage. from both sides of the aisle to protect conservation leaders in the legislature

Current Focus

Working with the DNR



- Starting in 2008 MBHA started working with DNR to make each years design the patch. Contest for students in K-12 public, private or home schooled to bear patch. Each year we have a Bear Patch Cooperator Patch
- Starting in 2017 MBHA with the help of College welder students we started building and donating bear traps for the Michigan DNR.
- Kirkland Community College in Gaylord built the first trap
- Ferris State is currently working on building the next trap.
