Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act," by amending sections 3, 11, and 15 (MCL 333.27953, 333.27961, and 333.27965), section 3 as amended

by 2020 PA 208.

HB 4251 (Rep. Bellino) A bill to prohibit the sale of vapor products or

alternative nicotine products that contain vitamin

E acetate; and to prescribe penalties.
