Dear Members of the House Government Operations Committee,

My name is George Kracht and I am a Purchasing Manager at Rivian Automotive, a fast-growing Michigan company employing over 800 people and investing many millions of dollars in the state already. I commute to Rivian's Plymouth, Michigan office from my home in Ann Arbor, so I am one of your constituents.

I am contacting you to ask you to oppose House Bill 6233, a bill that would prevent Rivian from promoting, selling, and servicing our products in Michigan—the very state in which these vehicles were designed and engineered. We can and should be designing and building the next generation of cars right here in Michigan, but this bill in its current form would stifle innovation, competition, investment and consumer choice.

Instead of allowing House Bill 6233 to advance, I urge you to instead support a change that would remove barriers to direct sales and service of electric vehicles in Michigan.
