The House Standing Committee on Health Policy was called to order by Chairman Vaupel.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Frederick moved to adopt the meeting minutes from February 21, 2019. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4057 before the committee:

HB 4057 (Rep. Marino) A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control

code of 1998,"by amending section 221 (MCL 436.1221), as

amended by 2018 PA 346.

Annette Downey, representing the Oakland Community Health Network, submitted a card in support of the bill, but did not wish to speak.

Representative Frederick moved to refer House Bill No. 4057 to the committee on Ways and Means. The motion prevailed 18-0-1:

The Chair invited Greg Hoke, and Stephen Rapundalo, representing the Michigan Biotechnology Innovation Organization, to give a presentation on the overview of their company. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair called Peter Fotos, representing the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America, to answer additional questions.

The Chair laid HB 4156 before the committee:

HB 4156 (Rep. Vaupel) A bill to amend 1943 PA 240, entitled "State employees' retirement act, "by amending section 68c (MCL 38.68c), as amended by 2018 PA 357.
