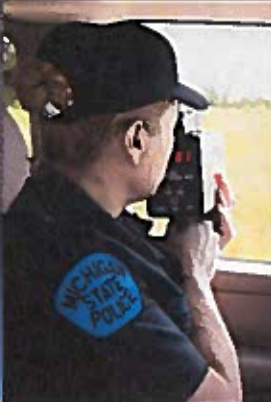
Vision

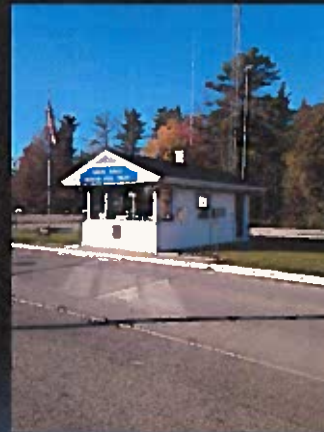

Size & Weight Laws

Michigan Vehicle Code (1949 PA 300)

- Road Classifications
 - Size – (Non-designated & Designated)
 - Weight
 - Normal Loading
 - County Roads (9,000/13,000/18,000 lbs)
 - Designated Loading
 - Roads & Bridges adequate for heavier loading
 - Special Designated aka Bridge Formula
 - All M, US, and Interstate Roads

Overweight Fines

Michigan Vehicle Code (1949 PA 300)

- Michigan has no weight tolerance
- Any amount of excess is a violation
- Fine structure cents per pound
 - First 1,000 lbs is “grace”, if excess <2,000 lbs
 - Excess may be per axle or group (Bridge Formula)
 - Fines directed to local libraries

Fine Schedule

- 3 cents per pound for each pound of excess load over 1,000 pounds when the excess is 2,000 pounds or less;
- 6 cents per pound of excess load when the excess is over 2,000 pounds but not over 3,000 pounds;
- 9 cents per pound for each pound of excess load when the excess is over 3,000 pounds but not over 4,000 pounds;
- 12 cents per pound for each pound of excess load when the excess is over 4,000 pounds but not over 5,000 pounds;
- 15 cents per pound for each pound of excess load when the excess is over 5,000 pounds but not over 10,000 pounds;
- 20 cents per pound for each pound of excess load when the excess is over 10,000 pounds.

Exception to fine schedule – vehicle would be legal by proper distribution

Recent CVED Enforcement

May 14, 2019 – A motor carrier officer from the Lapeer Post conducted a traffic stop on a sod hauler to investigate an overweight violation. The truck was legal at 80,000 lbs., actual weight 108,000 lbs. A citation was issued with an anticipated fine of \$6,000.00 plus court costs.

May 16, 2019 – the same motor carrier officer conducted a traffic stop on a Canadian carrier to investigate an overweight violation. The truck was legal at 99,400 lbs., actual weight 132,500 lbs. A citation was issued with an anticipated fine of \$5,550.00 plus court costs.

Both of these overweight vehicles were detected utilizing the wireless weigh-in-motion equipment on I69.

Michigan Vehicle Code (1949 PA 300)

- Truck weighing 8,000 pounds or less towing a trailer or any other combination of vehicles and for each truck weighing 8,001 pounds or more, road tractor or truck tractor,
