The House Standing Committee on Ways and Means was called to order by Chair Iden.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Lilly moved to adopt the meeting minutes from January 21, 2020. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5187 and HB 5188 before the committee:

HB 5187 (Rep. Warren) A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," by amending section 25 (MCL 205.75), as amended by 2015 PA 262.

HB 5188 (Rep. Huizenga) A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act," by amending section 21 (MCL 205.111), as amended by 2015 PA 263.
