PIME recommends to **add** or ~~delete~~ language as follows:

1. **SB 303**. AMEND to use the term **photo identification**.
2. **SB 0304**. AMEND.
  - a. Sec. 813. (1) ...by the elector using **current, legal photo** identification for election purposes, along with a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document to establish the voter's current residence address if the identification for election purposes used by the elector does not contain the voter's current residence address
  - b. If a person is at the wrong polling place and refuses to go to the correct polling place, that person should not be allowed to vote.
