The House Committee on Local Government and Municipal Finance was called to order by Chair Calley.

HB 4875 (Rep. Alexander)

A bill to amend 2006 PA 110, entitled "Michigan zoning enabling act," by amending section 205 (MCL 125.3205), as amended by 2018 PA 366.

SB 430	(Sen. Ananich)	A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 13f (MCL 777.13f), as added by 2002 PA 30.
SB 431	(Sen. Ananich)	A bill to amend 2006 PA 110, entitled "Michigan zoning enabling act," by amending section 205 (MCL 125.3205), as amended by 2018 PA 366.
