## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, April 11, 2023

The House Committee on Education was called to order by Chair Koleszar.

Representative Stone moved to adopt the meeting minutes from March 21, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4064 and SB 63 before the committee:

HB 4064 (Rep. Brenda Carter)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1164c.

SB 63 (Sen. Polehanki)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1212 (MCL 380.1212), as amended by 2016 PA 319.

The Committee adopted amendments to HB 4064 at the March 7th, 2023 meeting.
