**Did You Know**

▪ The corridors throughout the state are vital to economic stability and growth. Each year nearly **\$600 Billion in freight** is moved on Michigan's roadways.

▪ Approximately **1.9 million full-time jobs** in Michigan in key industries like tourism, retail sales, agriculture and manufacturing are completely dependent on the state's transportation network.

▪ TRIP, a national transportation research group found that transportation investment has a **return of over 5 to 1**.  
 ▪ **87% of goods shipped** in the U.S. are carried on highways.<sup>1</sup>
