Air Quality Division

- Air Permits for road construction equipment
example: concrete crushers
- Abatement for older structures which contain asbestos
- Fugitive dust complaints
- Inspections to verify compliance
- Transportation Conformity

Materials Management Division

Sustainable Materials in Road Construction:

- Fly Ash – Improves the strength of concrete
- Tires – Improves elasticity during freeze/thaw cycles
- Glass – Can be used in asphalt or concrete as an aggregate replacement, or part of a road sub base
- Foundry Sand – Replaces virgin products in road base
- Compost – Improves soil stabilization
