HB 4837 - Support

We must keep the QVF out of the hands of 3rd party entities, private companies and foreign actors seeking to influence our elections.

HB 4838 - Support with Amendments

In addition to the electronic poll book, voting tabulators should never be connected to the internet. The proposed amended language from KALEAT also states electronic voting systems not be programmed for weighted voting functionality.

HB 4839 - Support

Only verified legitimate registered voters should be able to request absentee ballot applications. This is a common sense bill that will prevent fraud in the absentee ballot application process.
