

Economic Value of Greenhouse Crop Production

4th Largest Agriculture Industry in Michigan

Greenhouse production of floriculture, nursery stock and vegetable production is a rich part of Michigan agriculture and has increased over 12% in the last two years. Michigan ranks third in the nation with 11.3% of total land covered by greenhouses.

The total economic impact of different greenhouse industries is estimated to be approximately \$741.4 million, accounting for 9,000+ jobs.

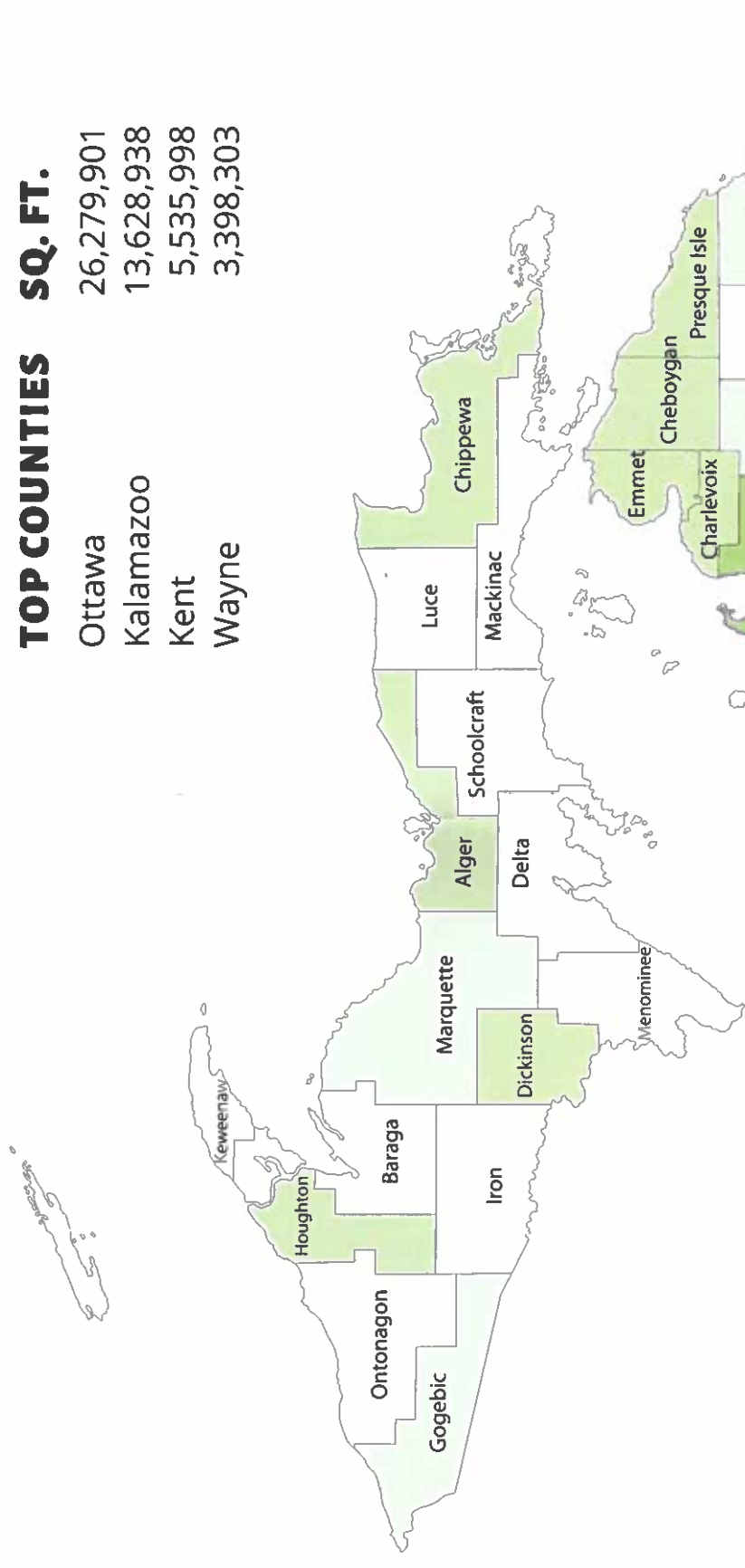

In 2018, producers had 47.9 million square feet of total greenhouse production, ranking it **THIRD** in the nation after California and Florida.

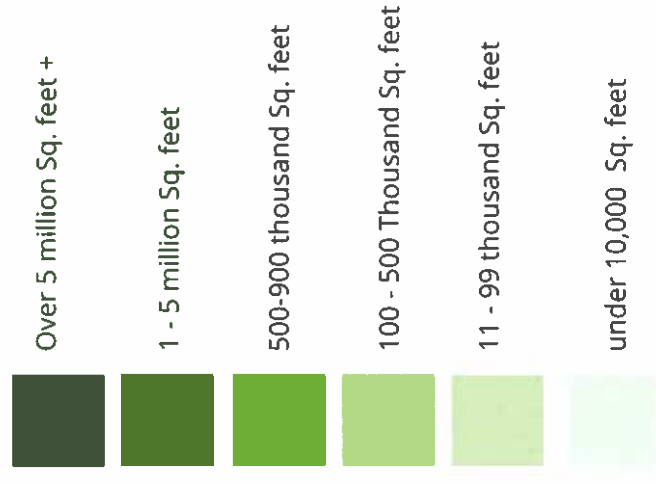
