COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, May 5, 2022 10:30 AM Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol Building

The House Committee on Rules and Competitiveness was called to order by Chair Lilly.

Representative Clements moved to adopt the meeting minutes from April 13, 2022. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5889 before the committee:

HB 5889 (Rep. Glenn)	A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," (MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2157c.
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Representative Glen testified in support of HB 5889.

HB 5719 (Rep. Hauck)	A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956," by amending section 3114 (MCL 500.3114), as amended by 2019 PA 21.
