The House Committee on Transportation was called to order by Chair O'Malley.

The Chair laid HB 5327 before the committee:

HB 5327 (Rep. Hope)

A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "Michigan memorial highway act," by amending section 67 (MCL 250.1067), as added by 2003 PA 195.

Representative Hope, joined by Rachel Starr, wife of Trooper Caleb H. Starr, testified in support of HB 5327. Questions and discussion followed.
