

I would like to express my sincere and deep opposition to HB 4603 and 4604. As an active practicing Architect and Architectural firm owner with over 27 years of experience, I'm shocked that these bills are even up for conversation. These bills simply undermine the very nature of the current Michigan and national structure of how Architects protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. With my 7 years of architectural education and three additional years of formal internship prior to sitting for 9 exams to become a registered Architect, I can clearly articulate that our profession is one of high integrity and focus on what is good for the public. We work hard each and every day to ensure a balance is achieved between the health of our communities, the needs and financial goals of owners and the many many regulating codes and standards which are constantly updated. We are the ones who guide this balance. Contractors support our efforts with great cost info, but they should never lead this process. They are simply not trained to do so, in Any way.

This balance is not achievable in a design-build format with a single architect working for a potentially bottom dollar contractor. Their world is often highly competitive and it is easy to win a project based on price. And you can be sure that price driven design is simply bas design. It is not balanced. Unfortunately, our public schools are already often treated poorly in terms of designing facilities which can maximize the education of our most precious children. The proposed format will significantly degrade the goal of creating environments which focus on the welfare of educators and the children entrusted to them. In my many years of experience, the only time I have seen design-build be truly worthwhile was in large warehouses or manufacturing facilities where few humans occupy the building. Products don't care how the building works for them. Children and teachers absolutely will feel the affects of a dollars driven project.

Furthermore, Michigan currently requires 2/3 of ownership of an Architectural firm to be registered Architects. Our State does not even allow interior designers to be owners. This is tragic that we would consider a contractor to possess any kind of ability to run a design project when the State clearly does not think Interior designers should be allowed to. Interior designers are thoroughly trained in space planning and creating environments that are healthy and safe for people. This should be reason enough to stop these bills in committee.

For reference, my firm does not do public school facilities, so I do not specifically have a horse in this race, so to speak. However, I am adamant about creating great places for people to be their best. I know from experience the power of well designed places. And I know how contractor led projects fail on almost every level for these goals.
