The House Committee on Transportation, Mobility and Infrastructure was called to order by Chair Shannon.

The Chair laid HB 4689 before the committee:

HB 4689 (Rep. Hope)

A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled "Michigan memorial highway act," by amending section 67 (MCL 250.1067), as added by 2003 PA 195.

Representative Hope, joined by Rachael Starr, wife of Trooper Starr, Trooper Patrick Arena, and Trooper Kristina Droste, both representing the Michigan State Police, all testified in support of HB 4689.

Representative Fitzgerald moved to report out HB 4689 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 12-0-0:

Matt Penniman, representing the League of Michigan Bicyclists, testified in support of HB 4012.

Vince Consiglio, representing ABATE of Michigan, testified in opposition to HB 4012.

Ed Noyola, representing the County Road Association, testified with no position on HB 4012.
