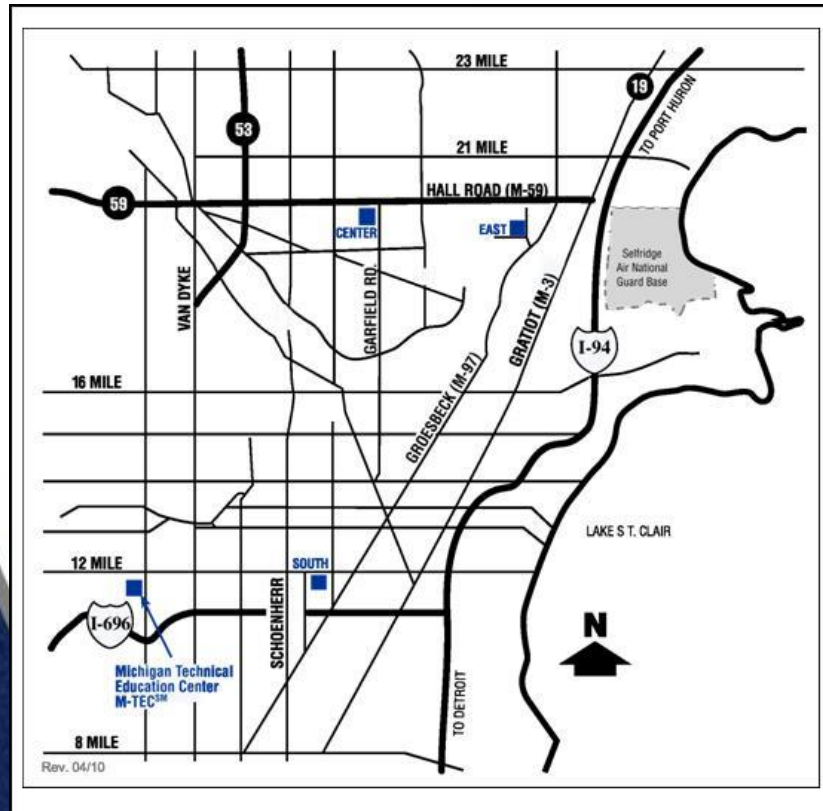


Overview of Macomb Community College

- 15,000 degree-credit students
- 8,000 workforce/non-credit students
- 200 degree/certificate programs
- 70% of students attend part-time
- Nearly 10,000 students received more than \$35 million in aid
- In-district tuition rate: \$111/hour

Macomb Community College Campuses

- 3 campuses
- M-TEC Center
- 418 acres
- 42 buildings

- Programs
 - Automotive Technology
 - Significant expansion of EV/HEV automotive programs
 - Climate Control
 - Building Performance and Energy Management
 - Civil Technology
 - Construction
 - Including licensed electrician and plumber training
 - Architectural Technology
 - Marine Maintenance Technology

Mobility and Sustainability Education Center

- 131,000 approximate square feet
- Total project cost: \$58,554,048
 - Macomb: 55% - \$32,205,726 (capital project funds)
 - State: 45% - 26,349,322
- Purpose for renovation
 - Enhance and evolve programs to meet the needs of Southeast Michigan economy including expansion of mobility related programs
 - Drive student interest and enthusiasm for careers in high-tech, high-demand, high-wage occupations
 - Provide state of the art learning environment
