Agenda:

- HB 4883 (Rep. Steven Johnson) Elections; political parties; requirement for members of a political party to pay dues in order to vote; prohibit.
- PIME POSITION: SUPPORT*
- HB 4995 (Rep. Steenland) Elections; ballot proposals; deadline to file petitions proposing an amendment to the constitution or an initiated law; modify.
- PIME POSITION: OPPOSE.* The increased time constraints will restrict the ability of the People to have a voice. More significantly, the bill lacks important limitations on the amount of time the secretary of state may possess a petition for review.
- HB 5926 (Rep. Martin) Public employees and officers; ethics; reporting lobbying expenditures; expand, and require SOS to establish a lobbyist and lobbyist agent expenditure database.

- HB 5927 (Rep. Borton) Public employees and officers; ethics; policy related to ethics on members soliciting gifts of travel rules; create.

HB 5928 (Rep. Bollin) Public employees and officers; ethics; Michigan electronic reporting and tracking system; update and expand.

HB 5929 (Rep. LaFave) Campaign finance; campaign practices; wages paid to candidates for public office, elected officials, and their immediate family members; prohibit certain campaign account expenditures.
