## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, September 22, 2020      10:00 AM      Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol Building

The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Afendoulis.

At 10:04 AM, the Chair laid the committee at ease.

At 10:08 AM, the Chair called the committee back to order.

Representative O'Malley moved to adopt the meeting minutes from September 15, 2020. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5778 and HB 5779 before the committee:

HB 5778 (Rep. Ellison)

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," (MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 9p.

HB 5779 (Rep. Ellison)

A bill to provide for the exemption of certain property from certain taxes; to levy and collect a specific tax upon the owners of certain property; to provide for the disposition of that specific tax; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities; and to provide penalties.

The following person submitted a card in opposition to HB 5778 and HB 5779, but did not

Representative Ellison moved to refer HB 5778 to the Committee on Ways and Means. The motion prevailed 12-2-0:
