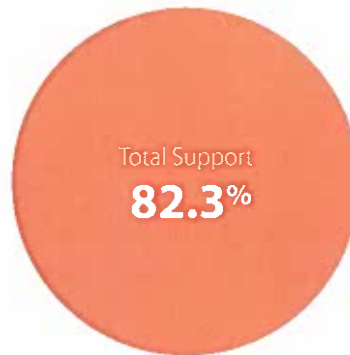

Michigan Voters Welcome Alternatives to Abortion

For the past six years, service providers in the state's Pregnancy and Parenting Services Program have offered counseling and assistance for low income women dealing with an unexpected pregnancy. For those who opted to continue their pregnancy, the program provided pregnancy tests, counseling, parenting classes, housing and employment, along with material goods for the newborn child such as diapers, clothing and formula, at no cost to the mother. Through 2019, the program has served over 8,700 women. **In general, do you support or oppose this program?**

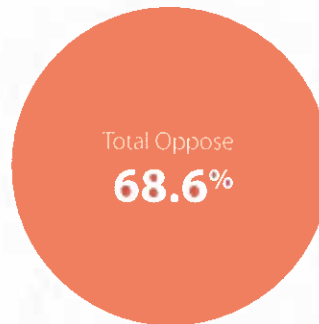
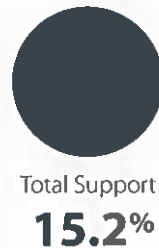
