On behalf the City of Muskegon, we are opposed to House Bill 4513 which would eliminate the authority to levy our city income tax on non-residents.

It would be detrimental to our income tax collections, as it would prohibit collecting income tax from non-residents after 2021, which accounts for 55% of our annual income tax collections.

The income tax supports essential services that depend on general fund dollars - Parks, Fire, Police, Economic Recovery, Community Services, and general services. Most of these employers still maintain a presence in the city where we remain responsible for keeping buildings safe and secure, maintaining public safety and infrastructure, and providing services to the community.
