## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Transportation was called to order by Chair O'Malley.

SB 744 (Sen. Chang)

A bill to create the maritime and port facility assistance grant program to award grants to owners of port facilities; to provide the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities; and to create certain funds.

Kyle Burlison, representing the Detroit/Wayne County Port Authority, testified in support of SB 744. Questions and discussion followed.
