COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, May 14, 2024

The House Committee on Criminal Justice was called to order by Chair Hope.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Harris joined the committee remotely.

Representative Andrews moved to adopt the meeting minutes from April 23, 2024. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

At 9:11 AM, the Chair laid the committee at ease.

At 9:12 AM, the Chair called the committee back to order.

The Chair laid HB 5569 and HB 5570 before the committee:

HB 5569 (Rep. Tsernoglou)

A bill to impose civil liability and prescribe criminal penalties for the nonconsensual dissemination of deep fake sexual images; and to provide for remedies.

HB 5570 (Rep. Bierlein)

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 17b of chapter XVII (MCL 777.17b), as added by 2002 PA 28.

Representative Tsernoglou and Representative Bierlein testified together in support of HB 5569 and HB 5570. Questions and discussion followed.

Rob Weissman, representing the Public Citizen, testified in support of HB 5569 and HB 5570.
