The Chair laid HB 4208 before the committee:

HB 4208

(Rep. Johnson) A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1249 (MCL 380.1249), as amended by 2018 PA 235.

Representative S. Johnson testified in support of HB 4208. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair laid HB 4262 before the committee:

(Rep. Reilly) A bill to amend 1978 PA 90, entitled "Youth employment standards act," by amending section 2 (MCL 409.102), as amended by 1996 PA 438.

Representative Reilly and Mike Winter, Michigan Christian Home School Network, testified in support of HB 4262. Questions and discussion followed.
