Debriefing - Facts

Defusing - Thoughts/feelings/experience

Grief/Loss - Support to COVID-19 specific loss of life

Stress - Support to COVID-19 specific challenges

Critical Incident Management-- Considering Setbacks

## Identified Needs (Perspectives from the Field)

Focusing on Engagement, Safety, Security, and Social-Emotional Learning, and Support

Responding to the "New Normal"--Recognizing and Supporting the Need to Change Roles, Expectations, and Practices

Leadership in Governance and Regulatory Issues--"A time for Grace"

Enhancing Communication and Connectivity at all Levels- Accurate (realtime) Information is vital during a **Critical Incident** 

## Identified Needs (Perspectives from the Field)

Increase attention towards Universal Screening, Multi-Tiered Level of Supports (MTSS), Emergency Planning, Development of Crisis Planning and Response Teams, Enhancing School Mental Health Capacity, and Supporting Integrative Practices that focus on the Whole Child.

**Presence on State-wide** workgroups that focus on Crisis Planning, Emergency Team Development, Critical Incident Management, Trauma Related Issues/Practices, and to study/respond to the longitudinal effects of COVID-19

**Ensuring** that Mental Health is part of the School Improvement Process

**Ensuring** that Mental Health, Wellness, and SELs are Fully Integrated within All School Curriculums in Michigan
