SB 184 (Sen. VanderWall) A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending sections 17905 and 17906 (MCL 333.17905 and 333.17906), as amended by 2015 PA 166.

 adding section 1205a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

laboratory animals no longer used for research to animal

protection shelters for adoption before euthanization; to require research facilities to submit annual reports to the department of agriculture and rural development that provide certain information regarding the release of laboratory animals; and to provide immunity from civil liability under certain conditions.
