# **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The House Standing Committee on Ways and Means was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Warren moved to adopt the meeting minutes from May 2, 2019. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4056 before the committee:

HB 4056

(Rep. Anthony) A bill to amend 2014 PA 462, entitled "An act to allow peace officers to carry and administer opioid antagonists in certain circumstances; to provide access to opioid antagonists by law enforcement agencies and peace officers; and to limit the civil and criminal liability of law enforcement agencies and peace officers for the possession, distribution, and use of opioid antagonists under certain circumstances," by amending section 1 (MCL 28.541).

Representative Lilly moved to report out House Bill No. 4056 with the recommendation. The motion prevailed 11-0-0:

The Chair laid HB 4095 before the committee:

HB 4095 (Rep. Reilly) A bill to amend 2006 PA 110, entitled

"Michigan zoning enabling act," by amending section 102

(MCL 125.3102), as amended by 2008 PA 12.

Substitute (H-1) was previously adopted to HB 4095 on April 25th, 2019.

Representative Warren offered the following amendments to HB 4095 (H-1):

- 1. Amend page 4, line 14, after "722.128" by inserting "AND".
- 2. Amend page 4, line 15, after "MORE" by striking out the balance of the subparagraph and inserting a period.

Representative Warren moved to adopt the amendments to HB 4095 (H-1). The motion prevailed 11-0-0:
