



Student Assistance

- Reading & Writing Studios
 - Assists with writing, reading and comprehending college-level texts
 - □ Assisted over 1,500 students in 2018
- SOS office assisted 354 students in 2018
 - Reported barriers
 - 46% transportation
 - 29% housing
 - 19 students reported that they were currently homeless
 - 36% food
 - 39% books/supplies

Veteran and Military Student (VMS) Services

- 293 unduplicated students utilized veteran services last year
- Over 800 visits to the new dedicated veteran space between fall 2017 and winter 2018
