The House Committee on Agriculture was called to order by Chair Alexander.

Chair Alexander turned the gavel over to Majority Vice Chair Bryan Posthumus

The Chair laid HB 4823 and HB 4824 before the committee:

HB 4823 (Rep. Alexander) A bill to amend 2019 PA 152, entitled "Lawful

internet gaming act," by amending section 15

(MCL 432.315).

HB 4824 (Rep. Hertel) A bill to amend 2019 PA 149, entitled "Lawful

sports betting act," by amending section 15 (MCL

432.415).
