# What is Phosphorus?

 Phosphorus is a nutrient that stimulates plant growth

• Can be found in soil, animal manure, fertilizers, etc.

Excessive phosphorus leads to algal blooms



## Phosphorus in Western Lake Erie Basin

- Two major sources for phosphorus pollution:
  - Point sources like wastewater treatment plant discharges
  - Non-point sources like agricultural runoff
- Goal is to reduce phosphorus entering Lake Erie by 40% by 2025
- Need to address differently going forward



### New Pilot Program

 Agricultural nutrient best management voluntary practices program

 Investment of \$25.0 million in one-time general funds

Focus on phosphorus reductions and water quality improvements

- Education outreach and training




