The House Committee on Education was called to order by Chair Hornberger.

The Chair laid HB 5097 before the committee:

HB 5097 (Rep. Beeler)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1278 (MCL 380.1278), as amended by 2016 PA 170.

Representative Posthumus moved to report out HB 5097 with recommendation. The motion prevailed 8-5-0:

HB 4199 (Rep. Hornberger)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1284a (MCL 380.1284a), as added by 2007 PA 101; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.
