COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Elections and Ethics was called to order by Chair Bollin.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Calley moved to adopt the meeting minutes from May 24, 2022. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 5254 before the committee:

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending sections 31, 683, and 730 (MCL 168.31, 168.683, and 168.730), section 31 as amended by 2012 PA 271, section 683 as amended by 2018 PA 120, and section 730 as amended by 1995 PA 261, and by adding section 730a.
