# Michigan State Loan Repayment Program

- Administered by the MDHHS
- Federal/State/Local partnership
- Goals:
  - 1. Assist employer recruitment efforts through offering up to \$200,000 in loan repayment to eligible providers
  - 2. Direct full-time primary care resources to underserved communities
  - 3. Increase the likelihood of providers remaining in underserved communities beyond their service obligation



#### MSLRP: Funding

- Federal Award: \$1,000,000 (max award)
- State must match 1:1
  - Michigan invests with overmatch of state funds
  - Where federal funds aren't used, there are no federal requirements
  - State overmatch allows extra flexibility
- Local employer contribution of 20% for most awards



# MSLRP: Eligibility Requirements

- Employers/Sites:
  - Must be located in a HPSA designation or facility designation
  - Be non-profit
  - Contribute 20% of the total MSLRP award

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



# MSLRP: Eligibility Requirements


#### • Providers:

- Commit to a 2-year service obligation
- Provide full time primary care to an ambulatory population
  - Family practice, Internal Medicine, OB/GYN, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Behavioral health or Geriatrics
- Have an active license with appropriate certifications




#### MSLRP Trends: NP and PA Participation

MSLRP Trend: NP & PA vs. MD & DO





#### MSLRP Trends: Behavioral Health






#### MSLRP Trends: Site Types
