# COMMITTEE ON TAX POLICY REP. MATT HALL CHAIR

### **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Wednesday, April 21, 10:30 Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol 2021 AM Building

The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Hall.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Tisdel moved to adopt the meeting minutes from April 14, 2021. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid SB 25 before the committee:

SB 25 (Sen. Barrett) A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," by amending section 30 (MCL

206.30), as amended by 2020 PA 65.

Tim Langholz, representing the Senator Barrett, testified in support of SB 25. Questions and discussion followed.

Paul Connors, representing the Michigan Department of Treasury, testified with a neutral position on SB 25. Questions and discussion followed.

The Chair laid HB 4221 before the committee:

HB 4221 (Rep. Cavanagh) A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," (MCL 206.1 to 206.713) by adding
