## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The House Committee on Agriculture was called to order by Chair Miller.

The Chair laid HB 4849 before the committee:

HB 4849 (Rep. Koleszar)

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending sections 2674, 2675, and 2678 (MCL 333.2674, 333.2675, and 333.2678) and by adding sections 2670 and 2675a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

Representative Koleszar testified in support of HB 4849.
