

Sec. 19##. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1, the department shall allocate \$1,700,00.00 general fund/general purpose revenue for a grant to Common Ground to support the expansion of a behavioral health urgent care program (BHUC). This one-time funding will support Common Ground's two existing resiliency centers as they work to be able to serve those suffering and affected by mass violence events who are not covered by Anti-Terrorism and Emergency Assistance Program (AEAP) funding, e.g., individuals connected to the greater Oxford and Lansing areas who are dispersed throughout the State of Michigan and rely on Common Ground's mass violence trained clinicians for care. This one-time grant will ensure seven days per week of virtual, mass violence care for those who are in need throughout the State of Michigan regardless of geographic location.

(2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for Common Ground's Virtual Behavioral Health Urgent Care Program are designated as a work project appropriation. Unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures under this section until the project has been completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a(1) of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

(a) The purpose of the project is to provide funds for BHUC services including trauma focused mental health assessments, psychiatric evaluations, short term prescriptions, intervention/therapy, and care coordination with ongoing health providers.

(c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$1,700,000.00.

(d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2027.
