BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2023-35 LR would make numerous amendments and an addition to the rules pertaining to the chiropractic profession. The changes would require telehealth patient consent and set conditions for scope of practice and standard of care, allow for more continuing education hours to be completed through distance learning, allow for more continuing education offerings to be accepted, and clarify additional continuing education requirements.
