BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2023-32 LR would make numerous amendments, additions, and rescissions to the rules pertaining to the real estate appraiser profession. The changes would add definitions, rescind and relocate some rule contents, revise experience requirements to exclude market analysis performance, update precicensure requirements, and align continuing education requirements with the Appraiser Qualification Board Criteria that goes into effect January 1, 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES
