
MIECHV was first allocated in 2011 and Michigan received approximately \$7.5 million per grant cycle in federal funding.

Federal match became eligible in Fiscal year (FY)24 at a **25% matching rate**.

In other words, for every **\$1 dollar of non-federal funding** that is not part of the state's MOE and other federal match strategies, **Michigan MIECHV receives \$3 in federal funding**.

In 2022, all MIECHV funding was reformulated as a **base grant and a Federal match Strategy** that states could apply for starting in FY24.

Beginning in FY23, Michigan's **base MIECHV funding**, prior to sequestration, is \$10,596,000 for two years. With sequestration that base is \$9,965,402.



However, at present, state funding will be unable to meet the required match for full funding after FY25.
