The remaining payments will be made on October 15, 2021 (\$25.0 million) and on October 15, 2022 (\$15.0 million). The case involved approximately 1,300 members that were incarcerated October 2010 through the date of the settlement, March 2020. The lawsuits claimed a variety of injuries including sexual assault and harassment, inappropriate use of segregation, and deprivation of educational and rehabilitative experiences due to the young age of the members. The case settled for \$80.0 million total inclusive of attorney fees and costs. House does not include funding in this bill, but includes it in a supplemental appropriations bill.
