This funding would assist with the local matching requirements for the Rural Utility Service ReConnect Program, RDRUS-RC-2022-2023 (USDA-RUS Reconnect). This broadband network will directly benefit 1,241 dwellings, 891 individuals, 55 businesses,

and 60 farms across Alcona, Iosco, Montmorency, and Oscoda Counties who currently don't have broadband access. Allband applied to the Make It in Michigan Competitiveness Fund (MIIMCF) and has been approved for the fund to cover half of the 25% matching requirement. We still need \$2,118,908 to cover the 25% match in its

entirety. The prospective state appropriation to match federal funds enables the deployment of the high-speed broadband network in underserved areas with a total investment of \$16,951,268. Allband is shovel ready and is ready to break ground in the summer of 2025., having already accomplished significant milestones, including design, environmental, engineering studies, customer surveys, and other essential planning.
