Proposal for the Acquisition of the Detroit Police Law Enforcement Explorers Command Post Vehicle

Introduction

For over 50 years, the Detroit Police Law Enforcement Explorers Program has served as a proven pathway for young men and women to develop strong leadership skills, self-discipline, and a commitment to public service. Many Explorers have gone on to serve in law enforcement, while others have become successful professionals and business owners, using the values of hard work, responsibility, and integrity instilled through this program.

To expand our outreach, recruitment, and educational impact, we seek funding for the Explorers Command Post Vehicle, a mobile unit that will bring law enforcement education, crime prevention training, career development, and mental wellness awareness directly to schools, recreation centers, and community events across Metro Detroit and Southeast Michigan. This vehicle will not only provide educational resources but will also act as an emergency response hub at large gatherings, reinforcing public safety and supporting youth in need.

Purpose and Justification

A key component of this initiative is mental wellness training to equip youth with the tools to handle stress, anxiety, and peer pressure while reinforcing personal responsibility and sound decision-making. Through this initiative, youth will:

- Learn to recognize signs of distress in themselves and others and understand when to seek help.
- Develop skills to handle conflicts responsibly, de-escalating situations before they become violent.
- Understand the impact of substance abuse on mental health, reinforcing the importance of clear-headed decision-making.
- Gain problem-solving and coping strategies that build resilience in tough situations.

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This training supports the values of personal accountability, strength, and self-sufficiency, ensuring young people are prepared to make wise, independent choices that benefit themselves and their communities.

Vehicle Capabilities and Features

The Explorers Command Post Vehicle will serve as a mobile educational and public safety center equipped with:

- Interactive learning stations for career exploration, law enforcement training, and drug prevention education.
- Multimedia capabilities for presentations on crime prevention, mental wellness, and early career planning.
- Storage and distribution space for educational materials, giveaways, and recruitment information.
- Emergency response support, including first aid kits, lost-and-found services, and crisis intervention tools.

- Private consultation space for career mentorship and one-on-one youth engagement with officers and Explorers.
- Surveillance cameras and TV monitors to enhance safety and enable live training sessions and presentations.

Funding Request and Cost Breakdown

We request \$185,000 to acquire and outfit the Explorers Command Post Vehicle. Below is the detailed breakdown:

Technology & Equipment	\$20,000	Laptops, interactive displays, PA system, surveillance cameras, and TV monitors.
Emergency Response & Safety Equipment	\$10,000	First aid kits, AED, fire extinguishers, and emergency supplies.
Mental Wellness & Crisis Resources	\$5,000	Printed guides, digital training modules, and outreach materials.
Ongoing Maintenance & Insurance (First Year)	\$5,000	Ensures vehicle remains operational and fully insured.
TOTAL REQUESTED FUNDING	\$185,000	Investment in public safety and youth development.
